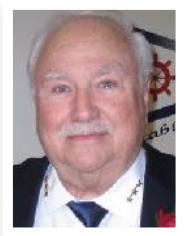
NOTES FROM THE COMMODORE

Hello all members.

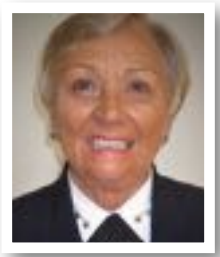
On June 1st our members Claudette and Nathaniel Calaway were married with a beautiful ceremony and reception at our club. Congratulations to both of you.

Notes from the Board of Directors

Why is it we wish for the warm weather and then when it gets here, we wish it was cooler. I don't think I need to tell anyone summer is finally here!

As reported last month the State Water Board has been testing in multiple areas in the Delta. Since last month weekly testing has taken place and the water in front of our club is now well within the normal ranges of E. coli. We should still have a concern of the levee encampments which contribute to higher counts. As you probably know, there are large encampments on the Calaveras River east and under I5. Please bring your concerns over this issue to the San Joaquin Delta Neighborhood Watch, which will be hosted by Village West Yacht Club on July 17, 2019, at 6:00 p.m. Our voices have been heard and actions have been taken regarding water quality and abandoned boats on the Delta!

We have something new coming to Stockton Yacht Club. For many years Bob Cain has maintained our website and member communications. He has provided his time and these services and has decided we need to go to a broader system. We have researched and come up with a hosted system (used by many other yacht clubs) and will be implementing the new system soon. ClubExpress will allow you to update your information, see, sign-up and pay for events, read your bulletin, receive billings and much more. I'm sure you will be as excited as I am as we implement this new one-stop shop.

Paul and I will be your Port Captains again for the month of July. Please let us know if you see any problems around the club.

REMINDER: Anyone using the pump out station, please remember to flush the lines with river water after you've used the system.

RBOC Report - Paul Clausen, Vice President North

Thankfully, most statewide issues that have arisen will not have a negative effect on Stockton Yacht Club boaters. There are initiatives that will close some anchorages or seriously limit the duration of anchoring. These are mostly to limit the number of boats anchored and abandoned, along with enforcing the black water discharge laws. The locations are in San Diego, Newport Harbor, and Richardson Bay. Some long term anchoring in the Delta may be limited for the same reasons.

SB 393 is on RBOC's "oppose unless amended" list. The bill will allow the state to impound boats for accidents when there is loss of life. The issue is where is the boat kept and who is responsible for the impounded boat. We want language holding a marina harmless and appropriate fees paid should the marina be forced to store an impounded boat.

We asked all involved with the Bay Conservation and Development Commission (BCDC) to answer a call to action. A recent audit of the Commission strongly suggested major changes that RBOC heartily agrees with, so we asked all affected boaters to please send a message to BCDC that the suggestions should be implemented.

How many of you have heard of the San Joaquin Area Flood Control Agency and the Central Valley Flood Control Board? We will hear more because they plan, at this time, to put permanent flood control gates in Fourteen Mile Slough before the entrance to Village West Marina, and another wall and gates closing Atherton Cove, Smith Canal, and the Louis park launch ramp. I will be watching this very closely as it could have an impact on the Calaveras as well. So far, the levee on the Stockton Yacht Club side has been declared good, but the Brookside levee is suspect.

Changes are Coming - Bob Cain, Frank Gurnee

We have been working hard on a new website that we anticipate will make the operation of SYC a bit easier and more convenient. This is a commercial system that we have a great deal of experience with so we expect a fairly smooth transition in a few months. It will look a little different but hopefully you will easily be able to find all of the information you need. There are many really nice built-in features of the new system, including:

- Register and pay for events online
- Renew and pay membership online
- Log into the site with your chosen password you never have to change and don't need to enter each time!
- Email members, officers, and event registrants
- A real time calendar reflecting new or changed events immediately

A very significant feature of the system is that it allows designated members to make changes directly on the web, spreading the work and responsibility, so important for the Club going forward. Some items may include the calendar and events, news, photos, membership, documents, surveys, forums, volunteering, and an online store.

Needless to say we will have detailed training for the folks most effected and easy to follow steps for the general membership. Stay tuned as we move into the 21st century!

PICYA Report - Ed Stetson

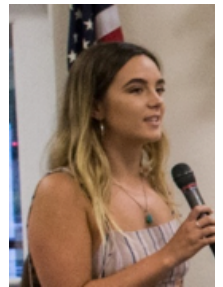

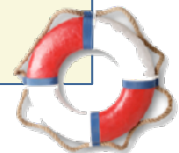

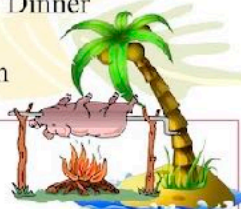
